Scope of Applications	1.1	In connection with the <i>Invitation for Prequalification</i> (<i>IFP</i>), the Procuring Agency, issues this Prequalification Document to applicants interested in bidding for supply, installation, after sales services of Computerized Hemodialysis Machines with allied accessories compatible with Central Monitoring Mechanism for Strengthening of Dialysis Services in Punjab. This prequalification is being carried out to ensure that only capable firms are invited to submit bids. 2. 	3.2	The applicant must be an active tax payer. National Tax Number (NTN) and General Sales Tax Number (GST) with documentary proof shall have to be provided by the applicant.		
	3.3	Firms of a country may be excluded from prequalification if as a matter of law or official regulation, the Government of Pakistan prohibits commercial relations with that country or for other reasons.		
	3.4	The applicant who is blacklisted either by any Government/ Department/ Agency/ Authority would not be eligible to submit the Bid. The Bidder will submit an affidavit to this effect.
